St Faith's

- 75 years old and still serving the community.
- Each week hundreds of people come here not just for worship but for everything from keep fit and dance to yoga and art classes. There are activities for the old and the young, for young families, for the aged and the bereaved.
- St Faith's is a busy place - a place where we seek to help build community and to share something of the Christian Faith.

But ...

- In 2009 it will cost more than £100,000 to keep St Faith's up and running and on top of that, we must raise a further £20,000 to decorate the church and another £8,000 to pay for repairs to the bell.
- Our only income is from what people give week by week and through efficient letting of the Parish Centre. St Faith's receives no other income from central church funds.

- We only seek to break even and perhaps make a modest surplus to keep back for a 'rainy day' but 2009 will be as much a challenge for St Faith's as it will for every other organisation of this size.
- Keeping St Faith's and the work it does in the community comes as a cost and if we want to keep it - we have to pay for it.

How can you help?

Please read the options below.

Donations

Every donation is very welcome, no matter how small. If you pay tax please use a Gift Aid envelope from the back of church which means that the Government gives us an additional sum at no cost to you.

Giving by Direct Debit

Many people give by Direct Debit instead of using the collection plate. This allows a regular income because it still comes to the church even when you don't! For those who pay tax, by completing a Gift Aid form we are able to claim from the Government an additional sum at no cost to you.

Become a Friend of St Faith's

Friends agree to give at least £1 per month to the Friends of St Faith's who exist to help keep the Church buildings and grounds in great condition. Over the years the Friends have made many projects possible.

Helping provide food for the homeless

Leave tins and packet foods in the baskets at the back of church. This is distributed to local hostels and directly to those who come seeking help. Many people often leave one or two items here from their weekly shop. Just leave items at the back of Church in the baskets provided.
