

KNIT AND NATTER GROUP

On most Friday afternoons throughout the year a group of St Faith's ladies, along with other interested knitters, gather in the Lowry Room to knit for charity - but also to enjoy each other's company and have a good natter. There are usually between 8 and 12 of us every week.

We seldom see exactly who receives our knitted blankets but for once we did. St Faith's Mothers' Union arranged a presentation by John Desty, a volunteer driver for Hope and Aid Direct, a charity which takes aid to Kosovo and other countries in Eastern Europe.
